



## European Regulation on Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of Chemical Substances, REACH

Dear customer:

In response to your inquiry regarding Crydom's activities regarding REACH, we want you to know that:

Crydom is fully aware of the REACH regulation which came into effect on June 1st, 2007. Also, we are aware of the six-month pre-registration phase that ended December 1st, 2008. We have contacted our suppliers of "substances, preparations and articles" to assure that all necessary pre-registration and subsequent registration requirements were completed within the time frame.

Additionally after careful review of the legislation, specifically Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, Title II, Chapter 1, Article 7.1 (a) and (b), it is Crydom's understanding that the products Crydom sells to you constitute non-registrable articles for their intended use.

Also, Crydom products (Crydom and Crouzet brands) **do not contain** any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as defined in Article 57 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, Title VII, Chapter 1 (IAW EU REACH/SVHC 28Oct2008, 13Jan2010, 18June2010, 15Dec2010 and 1June11, 19Dec2011 legislation).

Finally Crydom commits to:

- ✓ Offering its customer products and solutions that are safe, energy efficient and environmentally friendly.
